Arrival:	Flighth: Copenhagen Airport, Regional Train to Østerport Station, 0 change – 22 minutes traveltime or Metro from Airport to Østerport Metrostation – M2 change to M3 or M4 at Kongens Nytorv Train: Copenhagen Central Station, S-train to Østerport Station or M3 or M4 to Østerport Metrostation Car: Hotel Østerport, Oslo Plads 5, DK-2100 København Ø, Domus Medica, Kristianiagade 12, DK-2100 København Ø Parking on the streets, payment.
Accomodation:	Hotel Østerport, Oslo Plads 5, DK-2100 København Ø Close to Meeting facilities – 5 minutes walking distance. Other Hotels – look Inner City – 20 minutes walking distance
Meeting facilities:	Domus Medica – Danish Medical Association, Kristianiagade 12, DK-2100 København Ø
Going Around:	Accomodation – Hotel Østerport – and the meeting facilities are in walking distance for the inner city of Copenhagen, but a City Pass Large let you travel around in Greater Copenhagen. Can be bought at all stations in ticket vending machines, 160 DKK/24 hours. Credit Cards accepted. Valid for travelling in the buses, Metro, S-train, regional train. For further info on Christiania look here Others: Tivoli: amusement park located in the center of Copenhagen close to Central station. The garden is the second oldest of its kind in the world. Louisiana: Contemporary art museum north of Copenhagen. Danish and international artists. National Gallery of Art: close to Hotel Østerport. Canal Tours: Cruise in the canals and harbor of Copenhagen. Amalienborg: The Royal Castle, housing the royal family.
Places to eat:	The New Nordic cuisine is well represented in Copenhagen with several restaurants with 3-1 stars in the Michelin guide – but Copenhagen is absolutely amongst the more expensive cities in the world. Look here for an overview of Michelin restaurants. All restaurants accept credit cards. Tips are included in the payment, but often a small amount are welcome - 20-30 DKK if you feel well-served.
Shopping:	A walking tour along “Strøget” and the side streets gives you the possibility of bringing home Danish Design and have a look on the medieval city of Copenhagen. Denmark is not using Euro’s but Danish kroner, DKK 100 DKK = 13,45 € or 13,38 US\$. € - are normally accepted in most shops in the shopping areas – as well as all credit cards.
Weather:	September is the start of autumn in Denmark – but could also demonstrate ‘Indian Summer’ with sunny days and more than 20 ^o C during daytime. 9 days weather forecast can be found here Sunrise 6:50, Sunset 19:20
